

Article 21: Appeal

Key changes

- Article 21.91 has been moved to Article 11 (Committees)
- The part on eligibility and composition of the University Appeals Board has been moved to Article 11 (Committees)
- All notices of intent to appeal now have to be sent to the Provost
- The Appeal dossier is now clearly detailed and comprises:
 - notice of intent to appeal;
 - original dossier;
 - argumentation of the appellant.
- The argumentation of the appellant and supporting documents are now regrouped in an annex, which must be sent twenty-five (25) days after the notice of intent to appeal.
- The verification of the original dossier and the constitution of the annex will start earlier.
- The UAB will now have forty-five (45) days from the notice of intent to appeal to hear the appeal instead of thirty (30) days from the receipt of the documented appeal (now the annex.)
- Twenty (20) more days are allowed if the UAB needs to get expert opinion.
- It has been made clear that signed copies of the experts' opinion have to be sent at least five (five) days before the hearing.
