This year, the Fédération québécoise des professeures et professeurs d'université (FQPPU) is launching a series of forums on professorial duties, beginning with one on university teaching.

Professorial duties are made up of teaching, research, and services, which are not equally or uniformly valued. Each of these components includes demands and challenges that must be acknowledged and examined to determine their effects on personal and professional life.

In the first forum, the FQPPU hopes to hear from professors about their teaching conditions, particularly in view of the importance of research, the influence of new technology, and institutional pressures and priorities.

The day will be split into three sessions on different topics, each beginning with several short presentations before opening up the floor to comments from participants. The topics are as follows:

- The composition of teaching responsibilities in relation to research responsibilities;
- Current and upcoming changes to teaching load;
- Recognition and evaluation of teaching duties.

The FQPPU invites all professors to this forum, which will take place in Montréal on Friday, April 25, 2014, at Salle Léonard-Gagnon at the ITHQ (3535 Rue Saint-Denis, Sherbrooke Metro). Spaces are limited, so advance registration is required. The \$30 fee will cover the cost of lunch, which will be served on site. Simultaneous interpretation will be made available if a sufficient number of participants request it.
