It has been 3 months since Professor Homa Hoodfar was arbitrarily arrested and detained in Iran's notorious Evin prison. Suspected of "dabbling in feminism and security matters," Homa has been left to suffer in solitary confinement for the duration -- without regular access to her family, her lawyer or her case file. Homa's health is declining rapidly: she has been disoriented, is barely able to walk or talk, and has a serious neurological condition for which she is not receiving adequate treatment. Apart from a brief period of hospitalization, requests that Homa be examined by an independent medical specialist have been repeatedly ignored.

The Iranian authorities are trying to break Homa's will and force a false confession to crimes she did not commit. Iran must know the world is watching while its court brazenly violates the country's own laws and legal procedures. We are outraged by these travesties of justice, and gravely concerned that Homa may not survive the mental and physical toll of her continued isolation.

Along with the Canadian Association of University Teachers (CAUT), the Fédération québécoise des professeures et professeurs d'université (FQPPU), and our sister faculty associations throughout Quebec, Canada and the world, we call again upon The Honourable Stéphane Dion and The Right Honourable Prime Minister Justin Trudeau to use all means at their disposal to secure Homa's release before it is too late.

**Homa is frail and ill and suffering.
Her time is running out.
Please don't let our cherished colleague die.**
